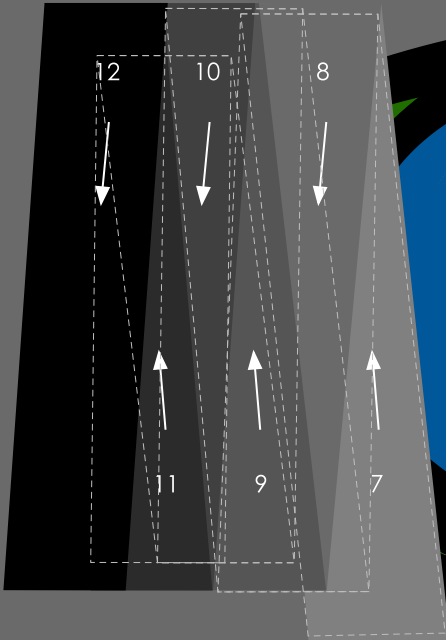


Back Rolling



Once your roller is running out of paint, which could be less than 6 rolls depending on how high you are rolling, you can start to back roll with light pressure on the wall. This will smooth out the paint that you just put on the wall and keep the thickness even. You will continue to do this as you move across the wall each time your roller requires paint.
